

He then originated "Valjean" in the Israeli production and was ultimately recruited by the show's producer to reprise the role in London's famed West End theatre district. He has recorded over 20 albums and has performed with Zubin Mehta, the Israel Philharmonic, the London Symphony Orchestra, and around the world.

THE FLAMINGOS & THE MYSTICS

Fans of the 50s and early 60s will love this night! Very few "Solid Gold" recording stars can generate the kind of strength that transforms them into living legends. Among the most revered exceptions are Terry Johnson and his Original Flamingos. Sharing the bill will be Rock and Roll Hall of Famers the Mystics, performing their hits "Hushabye," "Don't Take the Stars," "Adam and Eve," "The White Cliffs of Dover," and "Over the Rainbow." In 2015, The Mystics were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

SHIRLEY ALSTON REEVES

Rock and Roll Hall of Famer Shirley Alston Reeves is loved by all who have had the pleasure of hearing her golden vocals. Shirley started The Shirelles and sang lead vocals for the group. They quickly became known throughout the world with such hits as "Sha La La," "Baby, It's You," "Will You Still Love Me Tomorrow," "Tonight's The Night," "Baby It's You," and the group's mega hit "Soldier Boy." Come and enjoy a legend in music history as Shirley Alston Reeves sings personally for you.

TITO PUENTE, JR. SATURDAY, MARCH 30 - 8pm
